1. Inspect

- Check battery terminals for corrosion, looseness, or damage
- Inspect cable ends for wear, cracks, or swelling
- Look for battery case damage, leaks, or bulging
- Check battery age, if known

2. Charge and Test

- Fully charge each battery before testing
- Check resting voltage
- Test battery under load
- Watch for slow cranking or voltage drop under load

3. Confirm the Setup

- Confirm charger settings match battery type
- Check battery switch or charging relay connections, if installed
- Make sure battery boxes, trays, and hold-downs are secure
- Confirm the system is ready for expected launch-day loads
